#### PROCEDURE FOR ADMISSION TO A SHRINERS BURN HOSPITAL

Admission to a Shriners Burn Hospital is essentially the same as to a Shriners Hospital for Children. Here, however, it must be stressed that timing may be of utmost importance. The final outcome of a burn case may be greatly dependent upon the type of treatment and the speed with which it can be started. Therefore in emergency, the Chief Surgeon has the authority to admit the patient, having the application completed at a later date. If then you know of an emergency burn case, immediately call the Shine Ambassador in the area. Let's not miss a chance to put out a helping hand. Be a true Shriner!

## VETERAN OF THE MONTH

# JULY

#### Paul Barker

Paul entered the Army in October, 1958 and attended Fort Dix, New Jersey for Basic Combat Training and then onto Aberdeen Proving Grounds for Advanced Individual Training as an EOD expert. He then went on to Camp Fort Drum, New York. There he trained National Guard Troops.

Following Fort Drum, he was ordered to the 7th Division, Camp Casey, Korea. After 13 months in Frigid conditions, orders came returning Paul home to Fort Benning, GA, where he served until his prospective date of discharge, which was extended due to the Cuban Missile Crisis.

Finally, after 33 months, 16 days, 20 hours, and 32 minutes (but hey who's counting), orders came releasing him from the Army.

Upon returning to his home state of New York, Paul became Master of Niagara River Lodge #785 and was a member of Eastern Star in Niagara Falls. In 1980, Paul came to live in Fort Wayne and worked in Kendallville. He joined Three Rivers Lodge and is a member of Highland Lodge. This past May, Paul received recognition for 50 years in Masonry.

In 2002, Paul was awarded the Gold Metal from the American Foundry Society. Furthermore, in 2004 he received the prestigious Walsh Award. In 2006, Paul was inducted into the Foundry Hall of Fame. In 2008, Paul became Director of Engineering at the Dalton Foundry. Paul spent 15 years on the Foundry Board of Education and served on the Board of Directors of the School of Engineering at Trine University. He now works with Manchester University School of Pharmacology.

Paul is a member of the Scottish Rite Valley of Fort Wayne, and was the first person to receive a Golden Passport and needs only 5 more degrees to receive his second Golden Passport.

As a Shriner, Paul served as Commander of GLSA Legion of Honor and currently serves as Finance Officer. At Mizpah, he has served as Recorder, a member of the Finance Committee, Hillbillies, and is also a van driver.



#### **Randy Page**

Randy enlisted in the Army in 1965 for 6 years. He was sent to Fort Leonard Wood, Missouri for basic training. From there he was sent to Fort Sam Houston, San Antonio, Texas for further training as a Combat Medic. In July of 1968, Gary, Indiana exploded into flames as a riot took over much of the city, and Randy's unit was sent in to the city to help restore peace in the city.

In 1971, Randy received his Honorable Discharge from the Army. Returning home, he became a career truck driver, logging over 4.5 Million, accident free miles driving for Essex Wire, Holland Motor Freight and Power Seal.

Randy joined the VFW Auxiliary Post #2749 Kendallville, where he served as Chairman of the Committee that brought the "Traveling Wall" to Rome City, IN. Randy also became a Life Member of American Legion Post #381 in Rome City, where he served as Commander in 2007-2008. Randy still serves the Post as a member of the Post Honor Guard. Still not feeling that he had done enough, he became the leader of the 40 and 8 as the Grand Chef de Gare.

Randy server as the Commander of Indiana, of Sous Box Car Director for the region comprised of Indiana, Ohio, Illinois, Michigan, and the Country of Germany.
