Recorder's Message ...

Greetings Nobles and families!

Fall is surely upon us and Winter is closing in, so our Temple year is about to end. We honor our Hospital Van Divers at our November Stated Meeting. These Noble gentlemen are the face of Shriners to so many patients each year. Their 285 trips totaled in excess of 90,500 miles handling precious cargo. Van Drivers, we salute you and do hope you will join us November 20 for our meal and your recognition at the Stated Meeting. Remember, your spouse or significant other is invited to attend the meal and the open portion of the meeting. You may also wish to bring along a Mason who is not yet a Shriner and give him the opportunity to see our sessions.

Then we move to December and our annual Election, On December 6. As you will note in other portions of this Allah Bi issue there is NOT a stated meeting on the third Wednesday of December. Our by-laws require that we come together on the **First Friday of December** at 7:00 pm to **Elect our Officers and certain committee members** for the following year(s). Please note if you intend to be a candidate there are strict regulations as to how one may promote himself for office. Read the notice in this publication. If you have questions, please contact me.

It is my responsibility to advise that the 2025 **DUES ARE DUE!** Shriners International has updated in Web Fez and mailed the paper Dues Notices on September 1. Your dues payment includes Mizpah dues (\$75) plus a \$5 mandatory hospital donation and the per capita of \$50 for Shriner International for a **total of \$130.00**. These **DUES MUST BE PAID BEFORE DECEMBER 31, 2024**, to remain in GOOD STANDING. After that date, your card will show that you are delinquent and according to our bylaws you cannot participate in Shrine functions. If you have an issue and cannot pay the dues, please let a Divan member know, before December 31. We have various methods to assist.

This is the LAST YEAR for distribution of "year" stickers for plastic cards. Shrine International moves totally to Web Fez and the "My Fez Card" app. In the new year, your attendance at meetings and functions will be tracked for you electronically and your Dues payments recorded. If not paid for the year, you will be directed to the Recorder's office for action.

This learning year has been exceptional for me. Thank you for your support and grace as I worked through the process of understanding each of the roles of the Recorder. I am pleased to report that our 990 Federal tax return is filed before the extension deadline and that we are working on the preparation of the 2024 filings in this next year. We will be timely!

Annual Reminder: All Clubs and Units: Begin now to prepare for year-end activities and reports. **You must hold your Election of Officers AND report the results to the Recorder by November 30. The Recorder must file a report of the new officer corps for every unit and club on December 1 with Shriners International.** You may install your officers at any time; the requirement is that your elections must be reported by November 30.

My Lady Linda and I wish each of you a blessed holiday season. May you find Peace throughout the New Year. Please be careful and remember to love one another.

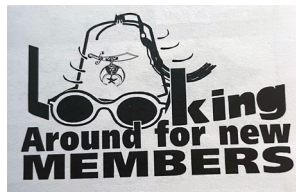

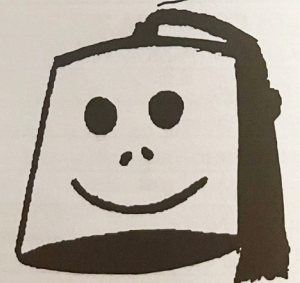

Election – Special Notice ...

We will not have a stated meeting in December. However, we will have a meeting on Friday, December 6, 2024, for the purpose of electing officers, and representatives for the year 2025. This is not a dinner meeting, the meeting starts at 7:00 pm.

Imperial Election Regulations 325.11 are as follows:

(a) **Electioneering.** A candidate for an elected office in a Shrine temple may print, publish and circulate during the year he is seeking the elected office, a resume consisting of his educational background, his vocational history, and his Masonic and Shrine record. Except as provided in the prior sentence, the printing, publication, circulating or distribution of resolutions, letters, telegrams, tickets, email or other devices, by a unit, club, Noble, or group of Nobles, suggesting recommending, opposing, or containing the names of proposed candidates for office in the temple is prohibited.

(b) **Expenditures Prohibited.** The expenditure of money for gifts, favors, or entertainment on behalf of a candidate for elected office is prohibited.

(c) **Violation.** For any violation of (a) or (b), the Imperial Potentate may suspend an offending Noble, and he may declare the election of the officers void and order a new election.

(d) **Dues.** Current 2024 dues card is necessary for admission.

Rehabilitation and prosthetics help Anita be herself again

A teenager from Georgia is laughing, walking and able to care for herself again thanks to three months of care at Shriners Children's Chicago, nine months total away from home.

Anita, 14, got a random swollen foot on Christmas Day. Emergency room doctors determined her body was actually shutting down due to a combination of strep A and flu B in her bloodstream. She almost died multiple times. The treatment to save her life meant she lost both lower legs.



She came to Shriners Children's Chicago for intensive inpatient rehabilitation, also unable to move her arms either.

Three months later she has her sparkle back and

Noble's we are all ONE SHRINE. We have no secrets in the Car Club. If you want to know how or why we do what we do, come and talk to us.

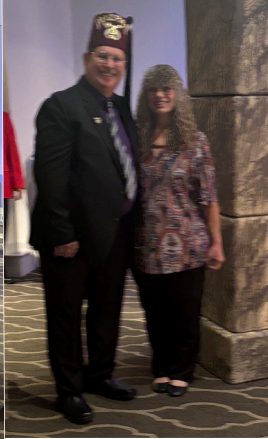
