

Proposed Resolution to Bylaws of MIZPAH SHRINERS Article 5 Supplement 5.1

§ 5.1 Initiation Fee: The initiation fee shall be determined at a stated or special meeting of the temple after a notice has been given to each member stating the proposed amount of the initiation fee. The initiation fee shall not be less than the prescribed by the bylaws of Shriners International. It must be paid in full prior to initiation.

§5.1 Initiation Fee Resolution additions below:

- (a) Amount. The Mizpah Shrine Temple candidate's yearly initiation fee shall be \$50. The Mizpah Shrine initiation fee allocation amount receivable from candidate for dues, per capita tax and hospital assessment as of January 1 should be computed and added as necessary to the yearly initiation fee amount at the beginning of the year.
- (b) Prepayment. A candidate may not be initiated until his initiation fee and Fez is paid in full.
 - The Mizpah Temple may provide new Nobles with a Fez as part of their initiation fee. The Mizpah Shrine temple may, in its discretion, allow the initiation fee and Fez to be paid by credit card.
- (c) Rebate Prohibited. No portion of any fee may be rebated or refunded in any manner to the initiated candidate, either in money or material. The Mizpah Shrine Temple may provide new Nobles with a Fez as part of their initiation fee. The provision of a Fez to a new Noble is not considered a rebate
- (d) Return of Fee. If a candidate does not present himself for initiation, he is entitled to the return of his initiation fee including amount paid for his Fez upon his request.
- (e) Change. Proposed changes to the initiation fee or fees must be presented in writing in the form of a resolution at a stated meeting. The resolution must be laid over to the next stated meeting or to a special meeting called for action thereon. The notice of such meeting must be sent to every member of the temple and it must recite the text or substance of the proposal. If the proposal is adopted by at least two-thirds of the members present and voting, it is approved.

First, to all those that have enrolled in the on line membership training from Imperial, THANK YOU. These efforts are going to be what's going to make 2021 a successful year. As always talk about what we do and be proud of what we do.

Fez 50. This is a change that is being read and published for a change as to how we collect out initial fees for initiation and membership. This will soon be voted on by the Nobility. In summary it is recommended that we remove the annual dues collection from the cost of initiation. This brings the initial cost to join down and makes us more cost competitive with the other appendant bodies. It also makes accounting easier. Please look for these details and be available to vote! Questions can be asked of the membership Committee.

In summary for 2020 I can say that we came in less 35 members for the year. So we still have some more work to do in regards to managing the membership database and overall recruiting efforts. With the help of the entire Nobility we were able to bring in new Nobles to help offset our losses. All this during a CRAZY YEAR!!!!. For all of you that brought in a new member, THANK YOU. The next step is to make sure our new members are well received and are participating in all the events we have.




