

Horse Patrol

The Horse Patrol has only a couple of activities to report this time. We found ourselves in our usual work position for the school day at the Circus. We parked buses. 
Gaining Trust – As Big as an Elephant - As Mighty as a Child

I recently read an interesting article, written by the Global Sanctuary of Elephants entitled, "What it Takes to Gain an Elephant's Trust." One conclusion was the need to recognize and appreciate the significance of each step of their journey, regardless of what it means for us personally. I witnessed such a step at our Mizpah Shrine Circus because of a mighty child.

Robbie and I met in December 2015, along with his mom and dad. He was almost two months old. It was his first trip to Shriners Children's Chicago. Now, fast forward to January 2023. Robbie is eight years old. We are at the Mizpah Shrine Circus in Fort Wayne. After the circus I heard Robbie was coming to the Circus Fair and was going to ride on an elephant. Shortly thereafter, I was told, "Come on. You and Dennis are going to ride the elephant with Robbie. You guys have had so many trips (to Shriners) with him. You are the right ones." I was shocked! I wasn't afraid; but I have



never been on an elephant. I'm the guy to keep Robbie safe! Suddenly, Dennis and I were climbing on the elephant. Then, here came Robbie. I felt an, "Oh my gosh!!" feeling! With one arm on the support and the other around Robbie's waist, off we went. What a thrill!! No time to be nervous. Not a sound came from either of us. A couple of circles around and we were back at our destination, safe and sound.



Down the steps and safe on the ground...... I didn't know what to think. I was in awe. Robbie trusted me to keep him safe. He is a mighty child. His mom trusted me to keep him safe. Off we went, with a purpose...... to have fun. We traveled a journey and came back safe again. Under God's protection and love, with the trust of Robbie and his mom, we arrived back safe and sound. I approached his mom with tears in my eyes and gave her a hug, saying, "You trusted me with your son. Thank you!" What a tremendous feeling.

Today's journey was as big as an elephant, but as mighty as a child. And he's a Shriners' kid. What a remarkable day. I can't really fathom what it meant for him or his mom. I could feel the trust and was just overwhelmed to be a part of it.

Now, a month later, I continue to reflect about that feeling of trust. Shriners make so many trips with patients to Shriners Children's Hospitals. We don't go by elephant; but we go by vans many days of every week. The kids and their parents go safely entrusted to us under God's protection and love. The patients and families board the vans, and with the Shriners, they make the trips to the Shriners Children's Hospitals. But that's what Shriners do. Another example of why we do what we do!

Having fun and helping kids. You don't find anything more special than that!


