

The Shrine Horse Patrol in Columbia City has put on an open Horse Show for the last 67 years to raise money for the Shrine Children's Hospital in Chicago. This is the longest consecutive running horse show in the USA! Each year we have tried to grow our AD book as the money raised through our AD sales helps us give even more to the hospital. 


