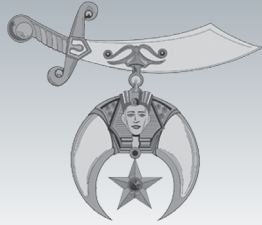

Dear Nobles

Former burn patient powers through Strongman events, becomes firefighter

Former Shriners Children's Ohio patient Steven wears his life on his skin. There's the ink from more than 14 tattoos and patches of dark and light beside raised lines, bumps and swirls. Every scar is like a map you can trace to the accident that changed his body forever.

When he was 14 years old he sustained second- and third-degree burns over most of his body after a gas leak triggered an explosion at his home in West Virginia. He was eventually transferred to Shriners Children's Ohio where he stayed for three months. He couldn't sit, stand, eat or walk on his own.

Veronica was just 8 months old when she came to Shriners Children's Chicago with a cleft palate -- a small hole in the roof of her mouth.

David Morris, M.D., chief of plastic surgery, performed two successful surgeries, but Veronica's care journey was just beginning. She was 4 years old when she returned for speech therapy with Sarah Richards, MS CCC-SLP. Seventeen months in therapy, she has graduated.

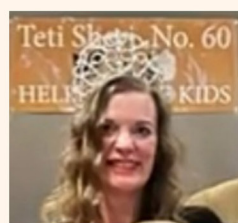
