

Horse Patrol ...

We have had the April showers so I guess the May flowers should be on the way. There is lots going on with the Horse Patrol. We had a wonderful Spring Fling. More than 200 fun seekers gathered for good food, fun and fellowship. As usual there was spirited conversation and laughter galore. Everyone must enjoy themselves because you see lots of repeat customers fling after fling.

For the last few years, the horse grounds have had more than its share of rain. Drainage in the arenas have been a problem. Most of the Horse Patrol activities center around the use of the arena, both for the club and rentals. The membership has decided it's time to fix our problem. Since we assumed that asking The Great Architect to schedule drenching rains to not interfere with our activities was not an option, we decided to work from the ground up. If the weather cooperates, before Memorial Day weekend, the large arena will be reworked with a new specifically designed, for our arena, drainage system. While we can't stop the rain, we plan to help it soak in quicker and get on its way to the large drainage ditch faster. This is a major undertaking for the Horse Patrol, but we can wait no longer. We have had to accommodate a sloppy, muddy arena too many times. Besides being messy, bad conditions put the equine participants in danger of injury or death. A broken leg on a horse is tragic.

We finished tuck-pointing the clubhouse late last fall. Again, the weather stopped us getting it painted. The paint crew will be tackling that soon. We have lots of parades planned for the summer. Our first will be the first weekend in May at Shipshewana. There will be several more throughout the summer and fall months. In May we will also start our drill practice every Thursday evening.

Don't forget GLSA will be here in September. The Horse grounds will be hopping. There will be horse activities, an oasis after the parade and dinners for several groups that evening. I'm sure

that I don't have to remind you all that the grass is growing, and we are mowing. Always mowing! Come help us mow or come see us at a parade! Whatever you do, just get out and enjoy the brotherhood of Mizpah Shrine.

Cone Beam CT (CBCT) technology comes to Shriners Children's Chicago

Shriners Children's offers specialized facial and dental imaging for craniofacial conditions at certain times in a child's growth. The painless process helps surgeons and specialists understand each child's unique facial anatomy.

The Chicago hospital's new CBCT installed in early March is a smaller than regular CT machine and uses less radiation. It moves around the child using a coned-shaped X-ray beam. CBCT provides doctors with a 3D image of the child's mouth, jaw, airway, neck, teeth and ears, nose and throat.

"Quality imaging is essential in order to accurately plan and time surgical procedures," said David Morris, MD, medical director of the craniofacial/cleft team in Chicago.


