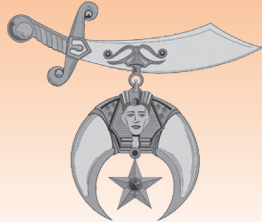

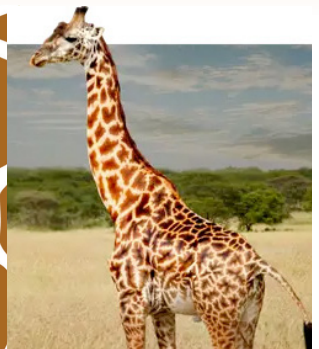

HOW TO USE WEB FEZ

Use WebFez to verify your personal information, payments and Shrine activity

How to Register for WebFez:

- Go to your browser's address bar and type in webfez.shrinenet.org
- Click the register button on the Login page:
- From the Registration page, choose your Temple from the drop-down list and then type in your Member Number and your First and Last names.
- Click on the Register button. You will be directed to the Create a New Account page. On this page enter an E-mail address that you will use to log in with, confirm the E-mail address, and then enter and confirm your Password.
- Scroll down to read the WebFez User Agreement and Privacy policy. Agree by clicking the checkbox.
- After the checkbox is selected, click on Register. This will Register you for WebFez and log you into the system.

Please see the "How To" on Web Fez. If you have not updated your information, please please do so!

✓ The new petition for membership is on our web site, in the Forms section on the left side of the web-site! Please use this form. You can fill it in on line and print it or it can be printed and then filled in. The new form reflects the new fee structure for admission. Just to clarify how Fez 50 works:

- o Petition submitted with \$50.
- o Vote happens
- o Noble is then notified he is accepted and gets a welcome email with his member number and a suggested To-Do list of things that will help bring him into an active status with us. This email includes calling the office and paying for / placing the order for his Fez. Of course, if other arrangements have been made for the Fez this does not apply.
- o Noble is then contacted as to date of ceremonial or Cold Sands.
- o Noble is also made to understand these fees are NOT membership dues. Those come out annually and the Noble is to pay those when he gets the dues notice.

First and Second Line Signers: Thank you for setting the example and bringing outstanding men into our great fraternity. Your efforts are crucial to our success and longevity. Please note that signing that petition is not the end. We need you to make sure your new Noble is not just brought in but also made a participating member of the Temple and its clubs/units. Coaching and Mentoring is a critical part of making a new Noble feel welcome and valued. Please be involved with this new Noble. Please make sure he makes it to the Ceremonial, even if a Noble has been through a Cold Sands, he is also expected to attend the next available Ceremonial. The Potentate sets the Ceremonial dates.

Club / Unit Heads: Please get your roster of members into the Temple Office. We need this data so it can be entered into the MDS system. This is a big deal as we move to further embrace the technology that is available to us.

Samsar Notes: New Jewels are on order and we look forward to recognizing more Nobles for their superb efforts in growing our fraternity. For those of you who are wondering about your points you can email membership@mizpahshrine.com and we can research your recruiting history. If you are a Samsar please wear your jewel! 

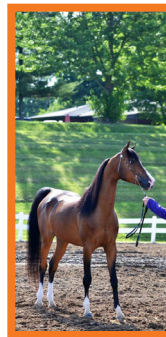

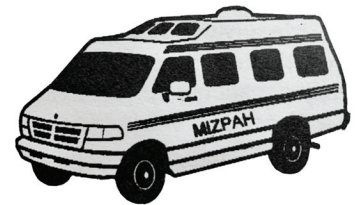
