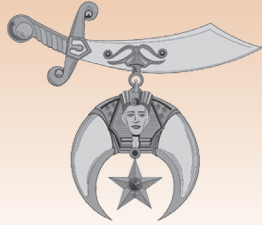

## Election Regulations ...

According to International By-Laws

§325.11 Election Regulations

- a. Electioneering: A candidate for an elected office in a Shrine Temple may print, publish, and circulate during the year he is seeking the elected office, a "resume" consisting of his educational background, his vocational history and his Masonic and Shrine record. Except as provided in the prior sentence, the printing, publication, circulating, or distribution of resolutions, letters, telegrams, tickets, email, or other devices, by a unit, club, Noble, or group of Nobles, suggesting, recommending, opposing, or containing the names of proposed candidates for office in the temple is prohibited.
- b. Expenditures Prohibited: The expenditure of money for gifts, favors, or entertainment on behalf of a candidate for elected office is prohibited.
- c. Violation: For any violation of (a) or (b), the Imperial Potentate may suspend any offending Noble, and he may declare the election of the officer's void and order a new election.

This year's ball committee invested in many items that may be used over and over again for future Shrine events. These items may be used in the Imperial Room and returned to the store room in the same condition they were found. Items include an arch, spot lights, lighted backdrop, gold chargers, floating candle holders, gossamer, chair covers (from previous banquet), and tall flower holders. More information will be available in the Shrine office.

fraud,

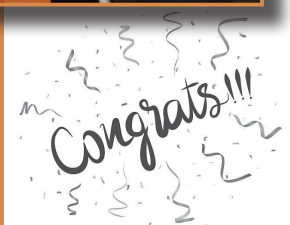
Should ever break the sacred cord,

What a year 2020 has turned out to be. Face masks, social distancing, small group meetings, etc. The Car Club discussed all of this and much more as we evaluated the safety and feasibility of having a car show in Lawton Park. With so many other events being cancelled we wanted to make sure we respected the safety of those who might attend as well as the Nobles supporting the show.

To achieve this, we reached out to other car show hosts asking why they cancelled (all said it was due to the facility they use restricting access), the FW Parks Dept, the Board of Health and potential participants. At the end of the day, each group approved the event. With approvals in hand, we moved forward and held the Car Show as planned.

When all the dust settled, the support we received from our sponsors was nothing short of amazing. Most notably we had two key sponsors who were unable to support the show, so the car club went to work. We raised more in cash donations in 2020 than we did in 2019 even without those key sponsors and the impacts to their business from Covid.

Ultimately, we had one of our best shows ever. The weather was on the warm side, but the shade of the trees and a steady breeze made the day enjoyable. We had 150 cars on display, one of which was a multimillion-dollar 1966 GT40 that was at Lemans in the 60's and Pebble Beach last year. We had approximately 225 people in attendance, the DJ played an assortment of 60's & 70's music, the Grille Masters along with the Trolley cooked lots of good food. and Whip and Chill served up an assortment of cold items.

Ultimately, if we followed the trend we would have cancelled. But we did our research and moved forward with great results. I think there is opportunity to stay safe while still achieving our goals. With all the negative impacts we are facing we need to seek new and innovative ways as a Shrine to continue to grow. Maybe the new path is via phone and skype or small group meetings? Either way we need to stay focused and continue to move forward.

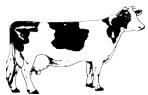
