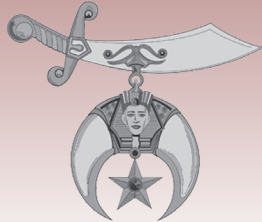

Use WebFez to verify your personal information, payments and Shrine activity

How to Register for WebFez:

- Go to your browser's address bar and type in webfez.shrinenet.org
- Click the register button on the Login page:
- From the Registration page, choose your Temple from the drop-down list and then type in your Member Number and your First and Last names.
- Click on the Register button. You will be directed to the Create a New Account page. On this page enter an E-mail address that you will use to log in with, confirm the E-mail address, and then enter and confirm your Password.

Membership Notes ...

Several things to cover!

Please remember to use the current petition for membership! It is on our website!

Cost of a jeweled fez has gone up. Please make sure you verify the cost.

Fez orders seem to be taking a long time. Please be patient, and most importantly, if you are ordering something you need to pre-pay for it! If you need a Fez, we have a room full that can be accessed. Just reach out to the office or Fred Diehl to either purchase, borrow a fez until your new one comes in or just buy a used one. We also have the Fez supports and some cases that can be purchased.

Samsar Jewels are still on order. This program will pick back up as soon as we receive the new supply. Please remember, Fez on Jewel on.

Right now, we have 1705 Shriners. We are pending the loss of 56 Nobles for non-payment of dues. Losing this many Nobles will have an impact on every part of what we do. One less driver, one less helper, one less year of dues. Not to mention the bottom line financial hit for the loss of dues coming in. Please remember when you become a first or second line signer for a new Noble it is imperative you get that Noble involved, and keep them involved. Mentorship is so important to the development of a new Noble. We cannot stop the black camel. He stalks all of us. However, what we can do is try to prevent Nobles leaving after two or three years. We cannot win them all but to have someone just lose interest because they are not involved really hurts.

Lastly, I want to address the vote from a membership perspective. Membership is here to support and promote the Nobility regardless of what date we meet. I know some Nobles were disappointed by the outcome. I ask all of you to remain steadfast in your dedication to what we do as an organization. There is too much at stake.

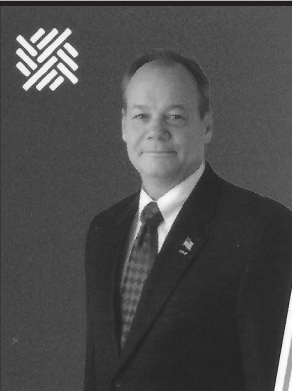

Election Regulations ...

According to International By-Laws §325.11 Election Regulations

- a. Electioneering: A candidate for an elected office in a Shrine Temple may print, publish, and circulate during the year he is seeking the elected office, a "resume" consisting of his educational background, his vocational history and his Masonic and Shrine record. Except as provided in the prior sentence, the printing, publication, circulating, or distribution of resolutions, letters, telegrams, tickets, email, or other devices, by a unit, club, Noble, or group of Nobles, suggesting, recommending, opposing, or containing the names of proposed candidates for office in the temple is prohibited.
- b. Expenditures Prohibited: The expenditure of money for gifts, favors, or entertainment on behalf of a candidate for elected office is prohibited.
- c. Violation: For any violation of (a) or (b), the Imperial Potentate may suspend any offending Noble, and he may declare the election of the officer's void and order a new election.

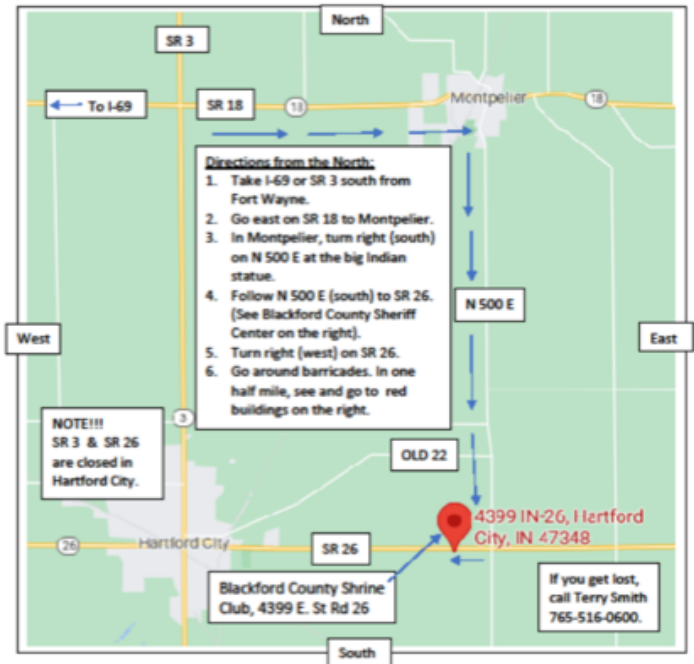
