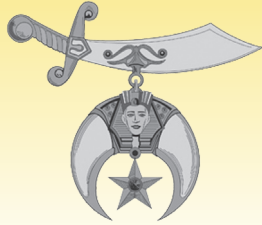

## Potentate's Message ...



Summer has been an active time for Mizpah Shrine Nobles. It is certainly great that many Nobles and the Divan have enjoyed much fun in June with the Potentate's Ball, the Etna Acres Golf Benefit, Indiana Masonic Home Foundation / Shriners Childrens Golf Benefit, Heritage Days Parade in Huntington, Old Settler's Day Parade in Columbia City, and the Mizpah Golf Outing. During July, Mizpah participated in the Shrine Imperial Session in Charlotte and the Car Club Annual Lawton Park Car Show. August activities began with Family Zoo Day at Franke Park, followed by the Mizpah Horse Patrol Annual Horse Show and the Fly-In Breakfast.

Do not forget September 9th is the Sportsman Raffle. See Steve Cowan, PP, Director and sell some tickets! Other events in September are the GLSA Meeting in Evansville 14th to 16th, the James Dean Festival Parade in Fairmount 23rd, and on the 29th the Night of Hope & Inspiration at Meshingomesia Country Club in Marion.

Also note the October 4th Mizpah Stated Meeting will be at the Angola Masonic Lodge. The Pokagon Shrine Club is very much looking forward to host Mizpah.

During the August Stated Meeting, two important changes were approved. One is to move the Mizpah Stated Meeting to the THIRD Wednesday monthly. This will begin with the January 17, 2024, Stated Meeting. This move is to not conflict with Blue Lodge Stated Meetings. The Mizpah geographic area has 61 Lodges, and the Committee assigned to research found that the FIRST Wed was the most popular night for Blue Lodges' Stated Meetings. I would like to thank Mike Hardiek, PP 2013 for chairing this Committee. The second change approved was to allow the incoming Potentate to schedule the Public Installation after the December Elections and before the January Stated Meeting. This will allow for a smooth Divan transition.

As the year winds down, I would like to address one of the main 2023 objectives was Membership Development. Keith Jacobsen, High Priest & Prophet; John Runge, Membership Vice Chair and Rob Jackson have worked extremely hard in this area. The Fall Ceremonial is scheduled for October 28th and open to the Public.

Another objective was "Brotherhood United" which is on my pin. I feel it is extremely important that we all work together to build the Masonic Fraternity, whatever interest a Brother may have. Therefore, Mizpah has coordinated with the Scottish Rite Fort Wayne Valley to support the 61 area Blue Lodges. Larry Chapel, PP 2008 / Valley Secretary and Andy Fracica, Oriental Guide / Thrice Potent Master have been important Brothers / Nobles in these efforts.

Mizpah and the Fort Wayne Valley hosted the first ever area Blue Lodge Membership Meeting February 28. This was followed by the Grand Master's One Day Class at Mizpah April 22 with nineteen Master Masons raised. Mizpah and the Fort Wayne Valley will again host the 61 area Blue Lodges September 25 to discuss Membership Engagement. This will be followed with the Grand Master's One Day Class at Mizpah on October 28.

Nobles, it becomes very clear that if our 61 area Blue Lodges are successful, many of these Brothers will then choose to continue their Masonic Journey by joining an Appendant Body. As Shriners we need to be active in these Blue Lodges and set an example, which can certainly lead to these Brothers wanting to become Shriners.

Nobles, come out and enjoy these many events / activities and show your pride to be a Shriner!

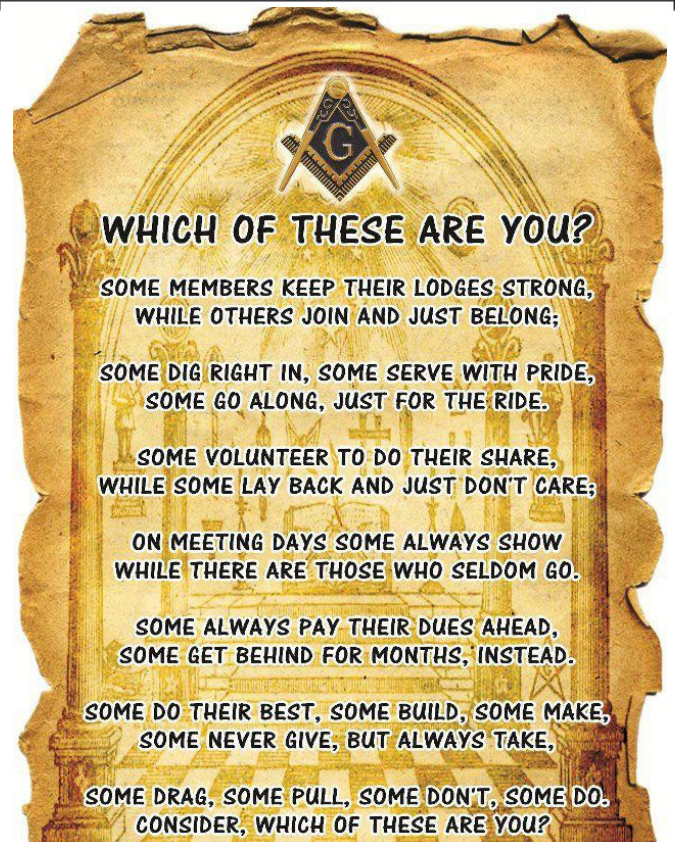

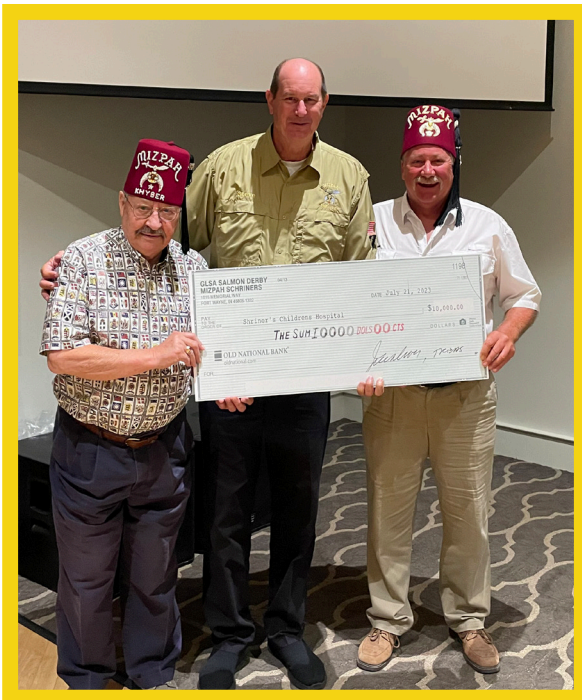
